Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,199
Single restaurant server	\$50,003 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,012
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,628 and \$42,920 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$642
Single nurse with overtime	\$140,341 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,949
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,050 median local wage; 1 child	\$201
Electrician family	One earner at \$85,654 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$442
Plumber family	One earner at \$80,857 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$442
Construction worker family	One earner at \$68,050 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$1,022
Police officer family	One earner at \$92,027 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$642

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,092 national firefighter wage proxy; married couple with 2 children	\$1,222
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,070 and \$38,050 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$642

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
