HOUSEHOLD EXAMPLE	ASSUMPTIONS	ANNUAL TAX RELIEF
Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,518
Single restaurant server	\$30,741 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$64
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,376 and \$42,755 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,078
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,697 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,120
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,031 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,242 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$340
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,499 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$340
Construction worker family	One earner at \$47,460 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$340
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,487 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$1,078

HOUSEHOLD EXAMPLE	ASSUMPTIONS	ANNUAL TAX RELIEF
Firefighter family	One earner at \$50,723 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$540
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,337 and \$37,031 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,078

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.

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
