Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,193
Single restaurant server	\$22,910 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$356
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,485 and \$34,259 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,810
Single nurse with overtime	\$78,665 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,808
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,641 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,517
Electrician family	One earner at \$60,328 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,804
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,328 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,804
Construction worker family	One earner at \$37,796 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,982
Police officer family	One earner at \$51,002 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,330

Firefighter family	One earner at \$50,405 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,307
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,437 and \$27,641 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,461

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
