Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,193
Single restaurant server	\$23,280 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$376
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,572 and \$33,601 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,848
Single nurse with overtime	\$80,205 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,862
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,294 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,981
Electrician family	One earner at \$55,946 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,495
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,029 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,620
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,582 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,982
Police officer family	One earner at \$61,644 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,087

Firefighter family	One earner at \$50,654 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,317
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,430 and \$28,294 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,504
