Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,193
Single restaurant server	\$23,436 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$386
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,942 and \$34,237 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,848
Single nurse with overtime	\$79,129 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,824
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,144 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,244
Electrician family	One earner at \$58,054 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,622
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,365 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,805
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,087 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,982
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,008 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,109

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$54,835 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,744
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$54,035 and \$29,144 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,542

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
