Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,193
Single restaurant server	\$23,228 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$374
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,671 and \$34,675 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,872
Single nurse with overtime	\$80,798 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,883
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,261 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,219
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,708 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,560
Plumber family	One earner at \$59,934 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,794
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,458 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,982
Police officer family	One earner at \$63,717 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,107

Firefighter family	One earner at \$52,852 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,453
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$54,263 and \$29,261 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,551
