Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,352
Single restaurant server	\$28,055 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$651
Teacher and office clerk family	\$58,499 and \$39,713 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,292
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,609 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,727
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,584 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,205
Electrician family	One earner at \$51,997 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,034
Plumber family	One earner at \$53,173 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,083
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,854 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,586
Police officer family	One earner at \$61,059 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,655
