Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,352
Single restaurant server	\$28,390 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$665
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,800 and \$40,844 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,468
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,348 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,792
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,892 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,128
Electrician family	One earner at \$53,991 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,117
Plumber family	One earner at \$54,341 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,131
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,137 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,894
Police officer family	One earner at \$55,308 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,269

Firefighter family	One earner at \$42,347 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,101
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,450 and \$29,892 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,483
