Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,352
Single restaurant server	\$27,658 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$638
Teacher and office clerk family	\$58,203 and \$38,800 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,258
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,736 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,695
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,725 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,734
Electrician family	One earner at \$52,962 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,074
Plumber family	One earner at \$51,978 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,033
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,521 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,586
Police officer family	One earner at \$59,596 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,620

Firefighter family	One earner at \$49,135 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,293
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,165 and \$27,725 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,571

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
