Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,107
Single restaurant server	\$38,595 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,257
Teacher and office clerk family	\$56,643 and \$47,793 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,492
Single nurse with overtime	\$102,621 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,582
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,426 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,519
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,317 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,860
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,355 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,917
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,136 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,021
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,136 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,042

Firefighter family	One earner at \$57,327 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,712
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$56,286 and \$37,426 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,196
