Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,107
Single restaurant server	\$38,902 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,280
Teacher and office clerk family	\$58,394 and \$48,183 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,551
Single nurse with overtime	\$102,874 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,591
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,710 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,530
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,677 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,870
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,874 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,931
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,526 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,038
Police officer family	One earner at \$89,755 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,087

Firefighter family	One earner at \$59,090 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,754
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,024 and \$37,710 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,224
