Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,107
Single restaurant server	\$39,852 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,353
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,484 and \$50,132 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,384
Single nurse with overtime	\$103,904 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,629
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,640 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,412
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,411 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,890
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,255 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,969
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,709 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,188
Police officer family	One earner at \$96,231 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,265
