Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,322
Single restaurant server	\$41,574 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,398
Teacher and office clerk family	\$105,121 and \$57,875 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$11,758
Single nurse with overtime	\$212,162 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$10,420
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,575 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,656
Electrician family	One earner at \$98,686 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,913
Plumber family	One earner at \$90,246 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,711
Construction worker family	One earner at \$72,866 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,238
Police officer family	One earner at \$150,493 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$11,442

Firefighter family	One earner at \$139,281 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$9,267
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$66,569 and \$38,575 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,287
