Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,322
Single restaurant server	\$35,347 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,052
Teacher and office clerk family	\$93,653 and \$47,855 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,403
Single nurse with overtime	\$134,220 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$7,357
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,359 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,520
Electrician family	One earner at \$76,679 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,342
Plumber family	One earner at \$71,375 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,198
Construction worker family	One earner at \$60,554 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,935
Police officer family	One earner at \$93,410 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,997

Firefighter family	One earner at \$70,447 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,409
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,772 and \$35,359 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,017
