Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,322
Single restaurant server	\$35,397 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,052
Teacher and office clerk family	\$94,918 and \$47,445 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,467
Single nurse with overtime	\$133,994 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$7,347
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,431 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,523
Electrician family	One earner at \$79,156 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,409
Plumber family	One earner at \$74,094 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,272
Construction worker family	One earner at \$60,822 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,942
Police officer family	One earner at \$85,836 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,791

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,590 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,993
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,973 and \$35,431 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,067
