Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,322
Single restaurant server	\$36,388 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,089
Teacher and office clerk family	\$102,831 and \$54,291 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$11,657
Single nurse with overtime	\$139,919 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$7,608
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,653 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,532
Electrician family	One earner at \$79,990 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,432
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,833 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,034
Construction worker family	One earner at \$60,976 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,947
Police officer family	One earner at \$124,450 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,918

Firefighter family	One earner at \$78,885 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,602
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,600 and \$35,653 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,074
