Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,322
Single restaurant server	\$36,398 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,089
Teacher and office clerk family	\$104,660 and \$48,304 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$11,553
Single nurse with overtime	\$137,886 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$7,518
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,274 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,516
Electrician family	One earner at \$78,409 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,389
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,340 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,042
Construction worker family	One earner at \$61,658 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,966
Police officer family	One earner at \$112,790 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,319

Firefighter family	One earner at \$79,359 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,615
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,238 and \$35,274 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,135
