Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,141
Single restaurant server	\$42,130 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$2,060
Teacher and office clerk family	\$77,651 and \$60,046 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$10,144
Single nurse with overtime	\$103,935 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,207
Single-parent home health aide	\$41,520 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,047
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,376 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,618
Plumber family	One earner at \$68,203 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,747
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,690 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,951
Police officer family	One earner at \$105,579 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$8,028

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$88,942 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,639
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$64,824 and \$41,520 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$8,041

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
