Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,141
Single restaurant server	\$36,236 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,536
Teacher and office clerk family	\$58,232 and \$53,229 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,004
Single nurse with overtime	\$95,137 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,865
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,942 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,931
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,026 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,578
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,922 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,576
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,630 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,116
Police officer family	One earner at \$91,208 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,363

Firefighter family	One earner at \$73,408 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,089
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,488 and \$35,942 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,689

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
