Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,141
Single restaurant server	\$35,897 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,510
Teacher and office clerk family	\$71,993 and \$62,447 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,933
Single nurse with overtime	\$104,396 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,228
Single-parent home health aide	\$40,052 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,077
Electrician family	One earner at \$66,782 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,708
Plumber family	One earner at \$68,149 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,745
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,990 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,552
Police officer family	One earner at \$109,346 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,957

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$94,179 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$7,709
