Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,021
Single restaurant server	\$39,102 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,218
Teacher and office clerk family	\$87,491 and \$50,606 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,367
Single nurse with overtime	\$112,286 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,079
Single-parent home health aide	\$41,283 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,714
Electrician family	One earner at \$82,903 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,697
Plumber family	One earner at \$71,175 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,994
Construction worker family	One earner at \$58,479 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,254
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,963 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,062

Firefighter family	One earner at \$85,589 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,970
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$63,621 and \$41,283 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,455
