Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$31,351 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$924
Teacher and office clerk family	\$59,247 and \$45,277 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,587
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,809 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,070
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,530 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,092
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,279 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,332
Plumber family	One earner at \$53,565 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,173
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,264 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,655
Police officer family	One earner at \$80,751 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,621

Firefighter family	One earner at \$61,853 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,739
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,993 and \$34,530 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,810
