Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$29,762 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$820
Teacher and office clerk family	\$56,246 and \$39,856 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,049
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,191 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,940
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,391 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,086
Electrician family	One earner at \$51,068 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,067
Plumber family	One earner at \$49,906 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,090
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,094 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,778
Police officer family	One earner at \$67,474 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,251

Firefighter family	One earner at \$52,743 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,144
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$49,011 and \$34,391 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,695
