Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$30,780 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$893
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,755 and \$43,624 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,666
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,602 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,062
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,016 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,070
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,069 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,195
Plumber family	One earner at \$52,641 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,134
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,675 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,541
Police officer family	One earner at \$65,353 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,024

Firefighter family	One earner at \$53,638 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,854
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,794 and \$34,016 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,818
