Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$32,771 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$997
Teacher and office clerk family	\$74,501 and \$45,108 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,893
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,690 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,990
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,124 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,117
Electrician family	One earner at \$59,225 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,655
Plumber family	One earner at \$53,481 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,170
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,907 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,588
Police officer family	One earner at \$69,972 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,320

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$55,929 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,383
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$58,610 and \$35,124 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,983

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
