Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$31,795 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$947
Teacher and office clerk family	\$55,640 and \$43,618 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,137
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,397 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,017
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,706 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,099
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,711 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,222
Plumber family	One earner at \$54,263 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,203
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,245 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,653
Police officer family	One earner at \$63,611 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,926

Firefighter family	One earner at \$49,070 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,817
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,130 and \$34,706 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,791
