Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$30,667 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$886
Teacher and office clerk family	\$60,622 and \$43,912 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,587
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,544 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,947
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,006 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,112
Electrician family	One earner at \$58,563 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,560
Plumber family	One earner at \$55,843 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,271
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,091 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,640
Police officer family	One earner at \$60,444 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,178

Firefighter family	One earner at \$47,955 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,778
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$51,242 and \$35,006 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,774
