Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$31,934 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$954
Teacher and office clerk family	\$54,925 and \$43,828 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,123
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,299 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,013
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,916 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,108
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,962 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,233
Plumber family	One earner at \$54,684 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,221
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,474 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,742
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,642 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,951

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$49,361 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,827
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$52,561 and \$34,916 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,809

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
