Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$31,944 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$955
Teacher and office clerk family	\$54,721 and \$43,846 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,118
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,304 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,013
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,954 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,110
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,986 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,234
Plumber family	One earner at \$54,742 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,224
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,507 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,744
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,535 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,948

Firefighter family	One earner at \$49,326 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,826
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,272 and \$34,954 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,802
