Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$32,639 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$990
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,455 and \$46,626 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,402
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,279 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,081
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,501 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,090
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,963 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,471
Plumber family	One earner at \$55,344 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,249
Construction worker family	One earner at \$44,250 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,775
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,223 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,578

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,926 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,933
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,714 and \$34,501 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,801
