Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$32,665 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$991
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,455 and \$46,676 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,404
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,336 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,083
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,520 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,091
Electrician family	One earner at \$57,010 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,479
Plumber family	One earner at \$55,410 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,252
Construction worker family	One earner at \$44,292 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,777
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,458 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,585

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,973 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,935
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,739 and \$34,520 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,802
