Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$32,617 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$989
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,341 and \$46,555 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,398
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,237 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,080
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,468 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,089
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,910 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,460
Plumber family	One earner at \$55,278 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,247
Construction worker family	One earner at \$44,188 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,773
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,068 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,574

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,577 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,925
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,300 and \$34,468 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,817
