Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$30,792 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$893
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,438 and \$45,350 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,347
Single nurse with overtime	\$88,384 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,091
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,906 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,150
Electrician family	One earner at \$53,634 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,176
Plumber family	One earner at \$52,004 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,107
Construction worker family	One earner at \$44,066 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,768
Police officer family	One earner at \$80,445 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,612

Firefighter family	One earner at \$69,170 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,298
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,280 and \$35,906 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,828
