Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$31,737 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$944
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,439 and \$46,820 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,407
Single nurse with overtime	\$91,141 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,151
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,380 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,128
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,224 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,202
Plumber family	One earner at \$52,166 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,114
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,884 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,622
Police officer family	One earner at \$78,324 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,553

Firefighter family	One earner at \$73,778 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,427
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$51,559 and \$35,380 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,794
