Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$31,262 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$920
Teacher and office clerk family	\$56,869 and \$46,418 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,552
Single nurse with overtime	\$90,089 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,112
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,253 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,080
Electrician family	One earner at \$59,048 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,622
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,445 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,551
Construction worker family	One earner at \$45,629 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,834
Police officer family	One earner at \$98,485 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,115

Firefighter family	One earner at \$81,914 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,653
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,391 and \$34,253 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,813
