Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,091
Single restaurant server	\$31,276 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$920
Teacher and office clerk family	\$57,011 and \$46,687 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,564
Single nurse with overtime	\$90,735 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,136
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,128 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,074
Electrician family	One earner at \$59,437 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,682
Plumber family	One earner at \$59,532 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,685
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,602 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,876
Police officer family	One earner at \$99,934 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,459

Firefighter family	One earner at \$80,115 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,603
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,746 and \$34,128 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,820

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
