Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,159
Single restaurant server	\$21,240 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$258
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,004 and \$41,801 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,394
Single nurse with overtime	\$91,742 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,196
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,623 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,247
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,383 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,295
Plumber family	One earner at \$59,660 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,221
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,243 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,827
Police officer family	One earner at \$59,723 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,184

Firefighter family	One earner at \$48,722 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,562
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,956 and \$29,623 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,961
