Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,159
Single restaurant server	\$18,726 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$177
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,810 and \$38,897 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,373
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,785 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,015
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,131 median local wage; 1 child	\$205
Electrician family	One earner at \$55,965 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,754
Plumber family	One earner at \$51,568 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,574
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,698 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,990
Police officer family	One earner at \$52,731 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,719

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$49,728 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,602
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$55,170 and \$27,131 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,763

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
