Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,159
Single restaurant server	\$18,940 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$187
Teacher and office clerk family	\$68,207 and \$39,000 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,786
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,338 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,998
Single-parent home health aide	\$25,881 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,621
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,176 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,796
Plumber family	One earner at \$53,632 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,659
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,088 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,989
Police officer family	One earner at \$49,873 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,607

Firefighter family	One earner at \$46,051 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,458
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$55,773 and \$25,881 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,745
