Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,159
Single restaurant server	\$19,428 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$210
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,490 and \$40,979 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,394
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,154 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,102
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,901 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,244
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,419 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,324
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,877 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,418
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,071 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,680
Police officer family	One earner at \$60,851 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,775
