Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,159
Single restaurant server	\$21,816 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$283
Teacher and office clerk family	\$79,120 and \$44,203 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,022
Single nurse with overtime	\$100,801 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,528
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,486 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,262
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,862 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,336
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,923 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,283
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,882 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,672
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,179 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,288

Firefighter family	One earner at \$50,516 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,633
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,909 and \$30,486 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,038

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
