Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,387
Single restaurant server	\$46,918 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,665
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,629 and \$43,929 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,911
Single nurse with overtime	\$147,033 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,914
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,948 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,384
Electrician family	One earner at \$90,472 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,761
Plumber family	One earner at \$83,228 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,565
Construction worker family	One earner at \$73,956 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,317
Police officer family	One earner at \$94,537 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,065

Firefighter family	One earner at \$64,953 national firefighter wage proxy; married couple with 2 children	\$5,873
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,459 and \$38,948 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,223

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
