Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,085
Single restaurant server	\$35,610 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,393
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,949 and \$41,833 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$8,071
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,163 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,664
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,716 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,959
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,463 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,569
Plumber family	One earner at \$81,909 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,284
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,761 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,087
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,773 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,562

Firefighter family	One earner at \$67,183 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,816
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,460 and \$37,716 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,807
