Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,931
Single restaurant server	\$32,368 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,069
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,811 and \$45,118 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,478
Single nurse with overtime	\$91,254 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,686
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,569 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,977
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,302 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,772
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,815 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,537
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,096 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,715
Police officer family	One earner at \$70,110 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,200

Firefighter family	One earner at \$57,084 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,407
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$56,448 and \$35,569 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,796

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
