Single restaurant server	\$30,863 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$977
Teacher and office clerk family	\$73,027 and \$46,454 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,805
Single nurse with overtime	\$91,583 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,090
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,484 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,594
Electrician family	One earner at \$102,128 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,627
Plumber family	One earner at \$101,959 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,622
Construction worker family	One earner at \$68,774 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,043
Police officer family	One earner at \$107,608 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,976

Firefighter family	One earner at \$83,814 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,653
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$63,369 and \$38,484 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,819
