Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,179
Single restaurant server	\$29,847 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,157
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,411 and \$48,037 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,351
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,156 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,376
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,379 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,359
Electrician family	One earner at \$68,098 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,301
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,690 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,290
Construction worker family	One earner at \$53,079 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,163
Police officer family	One earner at \$85,495 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,980

Firefighter family	One earner at \$70,183 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,559
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$65,426 and \$33,379 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,346
