Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,159
Single restaurant server	\$31,174 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$899
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,810 and \$45,984 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,862
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,065 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,981
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,794 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,294
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,818 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,368
Plumber family	One earner at \$76,798 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,340
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,303 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,047
Police officer family	One earner at \$66,031 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,136

Firefighter family	One earner at \$61,234 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,652
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,743 and \$31,794 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,995

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
