Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,190
Single restaurant server	\$38,414 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,267
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,309 and \$46,588 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,243
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,722 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,627
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,399 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,501
Electrician family	One earner at \$66,108 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,062
Plumber family	One earner at \$76,473 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,345
Construction worker family	One earner at \$51,187 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,011
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,978 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,696

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$58,084 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,711
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$58,165 and \$36,399 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,214

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
