Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,190
Single restaurant server	\$38,302 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,261
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,917 and \$47,439 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,468
Single nurse with overtime	\$95,389 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,983
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,558 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,428
Electrician family	One earner at \$85,225 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,585
Plumber family	One earner at \$86,077 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,608
Construction worker family	One earner at \$54,051 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,124
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,889 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,748

Firefighter family	One earner at \$65,238 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,966
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,295 and \$34,558 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,195

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
