Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,140
Single restaurant server	\$25,935 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$516
Teacher and office clerk family	\$66,892 and \$49,845 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,412
Single nurse with overtime	\$106,908 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,824
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,367 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,352
Electrician family	One earner at \$86,304 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,723
Plumber family	One earner at \$88,265 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,776
Construction worker family	One earner at \$62,235 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,825
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,297 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,995

Firefighter family	One earner at \$44,504 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$2,645
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,747 and \$38,367 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,992

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
